

How Blended Learning mode status being calculated?

Kaedah pengiraan status pencapaian mode Pembelajaran Teradun sokongan (PTS) **tiada** sebarang perubahan. Masih sama seperti semester lepas dan panduan kementerian dan PSPe sebelum ini.

Jika mana-mana pemilik kursus ada sebarang keraguan maka boleh terus laporkan di ICT Customer Careline (**ICCS**) beserta kod subjek berkenaan. Dengan itu semakan manual dan pengujian/simulasi dapat dilakukan untuk melihat jika ada mana-mana resource/activity dalam laman-kursus itu di KALAM yang telah mengikut panduan tetapi mungkin tidak dikira oleh sistem KALAMPlus.

How Blended Learning mode status being calculated?

1. In general, a course is considered to achieve support blended learning (BL) by following the 1-7-3-2 formula:
 - a. The course has course information (course info) on its course homepage.
 - b. The course has at least 7 **learning materials** (Moodle resources).
 - c. The course has at least 3 **online activities** (Moodle activity).
 - d. The course has at least 2 **online assessments** (Moodle assignment or Moodle quiz).

2. The formula is following the guideline set by the Ministry of Higher Education since PSPTN.

3. Course Info should be put in the general section's **Summary** area of a course homepage.

4. Specifically, the **learning materials** in Moodle are:
 - Uploaded files
 - **URL**
 - Label
 - Moodle Page
 - Moodle Book

5. The **online activities** are:
 - ✓ Moodle Forum
(Note: default Announcement area is not considered as Moodle Forum.)
 - ✓ Moodle Chat activity
 - ✓ Moodle Glossary
 - ✓ Moodle Lesson
 - ✓ Moodle Survey

- ✓ Moodle Wiki activity
- ✓ Moodle Workshop activity
- ✓ SCORM activity
- ✓ H5P activity
- ✓ Database activity
- ✓ Choice activity
- ✓ Feedback activity
- ✓ LTI (External) Tools

6. The **assessment** is:
 - Moodle assignment
 - Moodle quiz

7. Status of blended learning mode is calculated in real time against the KALAM database of active semester.

8. In UMP since Sept 2019, if a course owner wants to inform the use of **external platforms** outside Moodle/KALAM as learning material or learning activities or learning assessment then he/she can declare the platform via each **URL** module by adding the following indicator in the **Name** field of URL setting:
 - [LM] = for Learning Material
 - [LA] = for Learning Activity
 - [LS] = for Learning Assessment

If no indicator being added to the Name field of URL settings, then the URL will be considered as default Learning Material.

9. In 2020, a block plugin call '*Simple Blended Learning*' that contributed by UM vendor to UMP can be put in each KALAM coursepage as additional basic guide for course owner to achieve support blended learning mode status.
If in any case, there is a difference between the result in the block plugin and the result in KALAMPlus then the result in KALAMPlus will take precedence.
